About Us

Al-Tawheed Islamic Education Centre of Maidenhead (TIECM) was established in February 2009 when the current site at 22 Cookham Road, Maidenhead was purchased following the sale of our previous premises.

A decade later, our Cookham Road premises were demolished in 2019 to make way for a new purpose built masjid, which opened its doors to the public in October 2020.


We have grown gradually as a community and now accommodate the needs of over 500 people in Maidenhead at various times of the year. One of our goals is to project a positive outlook on Islam and give dawah to the local community through leading by example as responsible members of the community.

Our Teachings and Beliefs

Our masjid propagates the teachings of the Quran and Sunnah as understood by the pious predecessors.

Our Madrasa

Our madrasa is open to children from the age of 5 to 16. We accept students of all abilities from qaida to more advanced learners.



Qaidah

Recognition of arabic letters and combining letters to make words.



Quran Recitation and Tajweed

Reciting the Quran fluently with its proper rules and modes of recitations.



Salah and Supplications

Supplication needed for prayer and more.



Quran Memorisation

Starting with the small surahs of Juz 30 and increasing memorization at a rate tailored to individual students.

Class sessions

Our Quran classes run 5 days a week, Monday to Friday. We offer classes between 4.30pm and 5.30pm, and 5.30pm and 6.30pm.

Term Times

Our term time follows the academic calendar of the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead with the exception of the Summer 2021 term due to COVID19 disruption. Additionally, holidays for Eid Al-Fitr and Eid Al-Adha will be communicated closer to the time and subject to moon sighting.
