- 2. Covid cases are still high and therefore each of you (especially the elderly and those with chronic health conditions) should consider their personal risk and decision to attend accordingly.
- 3. Please ensure you wear a face mask at all times in the building.
- 4. Please keep 1.5m social distance in all prayer halls (with a mask). This will reduce capacity in all the prayer halls.
- 5. If it appears full please use the next floor up.

 Main prayer hall maximum = 65; Men's first floor =
 50; Second floor prayer hall = 50
- 6. There will be NO wudhu or toilet facilities due to the covid risk of transmission. Please make wudhu at home.
- 7. Please bring your own prayer mats this avoids contact spread from surfaces.
- 8. Please bring carrier bags for shoes this avoids gathering and contact spread at doorways. Keep shoes in bags next to you.
- 9. The Masjid will open 15min before the prayer and close 15min after.
- 10. Please pray Sunnah prayers at home and vacate the masjid after the fardh prayer.
